**Procedure:** You are given an injection of a radiotracer, followed by a scan lasting 30 to 60 minutes.

**Preparation:** You are asked to drink 3-4 glasses of water before your appointment time.

Bring any recent test results, such as **x-ray, CT scan or MRI.**

### **An important note for women having Nuclear Medicine Scans:**

As with any test using radiation, you must contact us before your appointment if:

- you are or may be pregnant
- you are breast feeding
