Your doctor would like you to have a **Gallium Scan**. The test is to assess for inflammation or infection.

Procedure: The technologist gives you a small injection in the arm. The injection contains a small amount of radioactivity. The injection will have no effect on you and you can continue with daily activities as normal. The technologist will give you a time to come back to the department 48 **hours** after the initial injection to take some pictures. Pictures take approximately 1 hour.

Preparation: Nil

Bring any recent test results, such as **x-ray, CT scan or MRI.**

An important note for women having Nuclear Medicine Scans:

As with any test using radiation, you must contact us before your appointment if:

- you are or may be pregnant
- you are breast feeding
