Your doctor would like you to have a **White Blood Cell Study**. This test is to assess sites of possible infection and inflammation.

Procedure: A sample of your blood is taken, which is then labelled with a radioactive tracer. Approximately 1.5-2 hours later, this blood is reinjected. This is followed by a **series of scans, at 4 hours after the re-injection.**

Preparation: Nil

Bring any recent test results, such as **x-ray, CT scan or MRI.**

An important note for women having Nuclear Medicine Scans:

As with any test using radiation, you must contact us before your appointment if:

- you are or may be pregnant
- you are breast feeding
