Your doctor would like you to have a **Renal DTPA with Lasix Scan**. This is a test to assess your kidney (renal) function. **Lasix Study** assesses possible renal urinary tract obstruction (a blockage).

**Procedure:** You are given an injection of a radiotracer, followed by a scan lasting 20 and then you are given Lasix injection and scanned for 30 minutes.

**Preparation:** You are asked to drink 3-4 glasses of water in the hour before your appointment.

Bring any recent test results, such as **x-ray, CT scan or MRI.**

**An important note for women having Nuclear Medicine Scans:**

As with any test using radiation, you must contact us before your appointment if:

- you are or may be pregnant
- you are breast feeding
