Your doctor would like you to have a **Bone Scan**. The test is to evaluate bony pathologies.

<u>Procedure</u>: You are given an injection of a radio-active tracer, which is taken up

by your bones. You are immediately scanned for approximately 15 minutes, and **asked to return to the Department 2 hours later**, **for delayed pictures.** You are asked to have 2-3 glasses of water

before coming back for delayed pictures.

NOTE: Test can take around 4-5 hours to be completed.

<u>Preparation</u>: You can eat and drink as normal. You should continue to drink

throughout the day.

Bring any recent test results, such as x-ray, CT scan or MRI.

An important note for women having Nuclear Medicine Scans:

As with any test using radiation, you must contact us before your appointment if:

- you are or may be pregnant
- you are breast feeding
