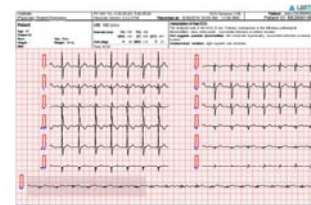
Recumbent Bicycle Ergometer
